## **CTUFC Fun Facts**

- We have about 70 members made up of professional arborists, city and other governmental entity personnel, tree nurseries, Citizen Foresters, and other interested citizens.
- Started in 1990 as Re-Leaf Tarrant County. Has gone through an evolution and is now a grass roots nonprofit organization supporting community forestry in the 17 county Cross Timbers Region.
- The money raised is used to support our urban forests in a number of ways.
  - Co-hosts a one-day annual conference attended by a wide variety of tree professionals and interested people.
  - Provides scholarships to students wanting to study forestry.
  - Provides for education and outreach concerning trees.
  - Sponsors tree related activities.
  - Sponsors the Citizen Forestry Program.

### **Citizen Foresters**

Mission: Develop partnerships between Cross Timbers Urban Forestry Council, regional municipalities, and individual citizens dedicated to restoring, enhancing and protecting the urban forest.

### Citizen Forester Rules and Graduation Requirements

#### Attendance Requirements

- Graduate as a Certified Citizen Forester if you miss one class or the equivalent of one class.
- Graduate as a Citizen Forester if you attend at least 6 of the classes.
  - You can earn Certification the following year if you fulfill the requirements.
- Your instructors and their employers are giving of their time to provide the training. We owe it to them and to our publicly owned trees to give it our best.

#### **On-going participation requirements**

- To be a Certified Citizen Forester you must contribute at least 20 hours/year of Volunteer Time and earn at least 5 hours/year of Continuing Education Time.
- To be a Citizen Forester you must contribute at least 10 hours of Volunteer Time.
- You can go back and forth between Certified Citizen Forester and Citizen Forester.
- If you go two years without achieving at least meeting the Citizen Forester requirements you must repeat the training to participate in the program.
