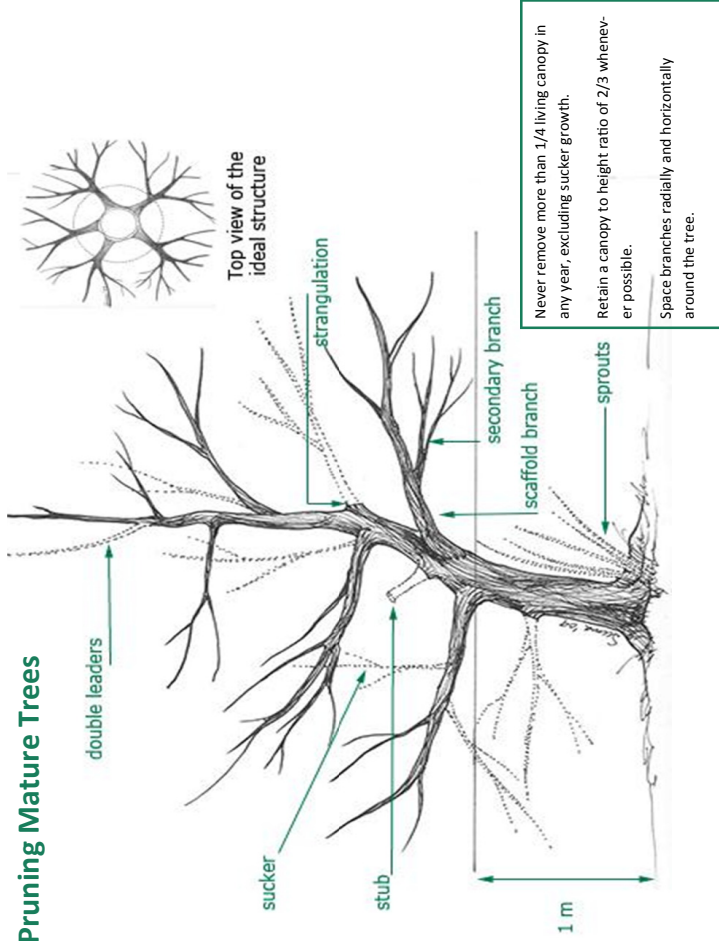
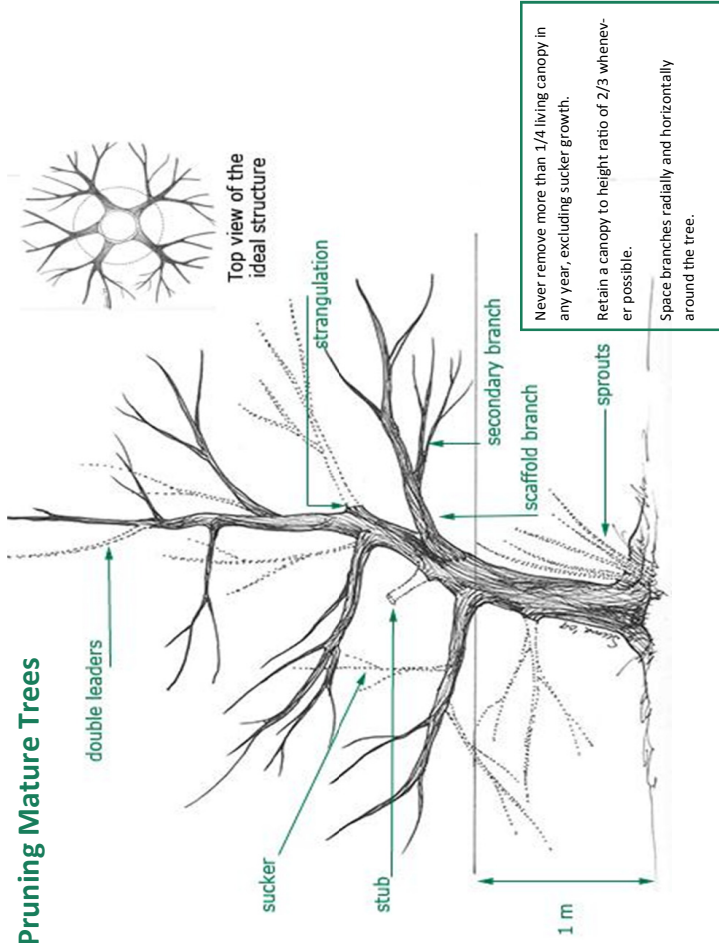


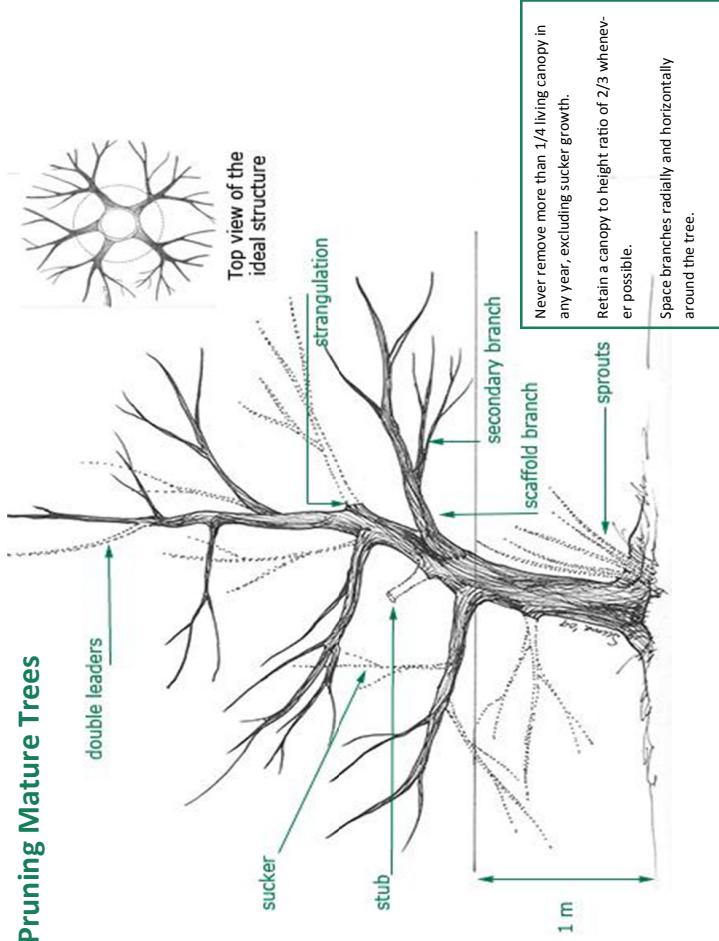
Pruning Mature Trees



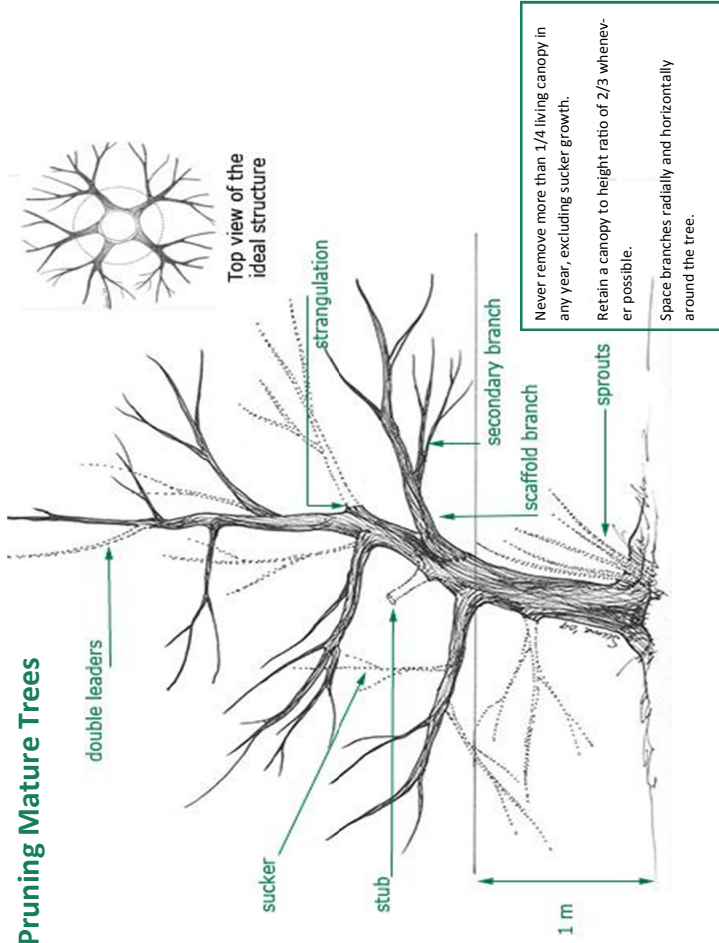
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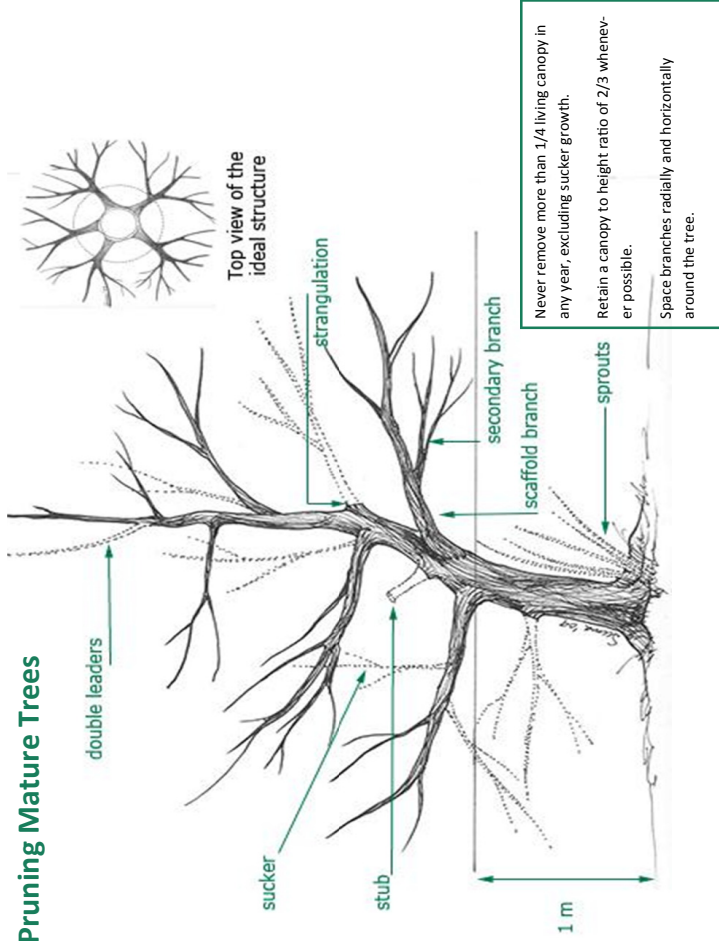
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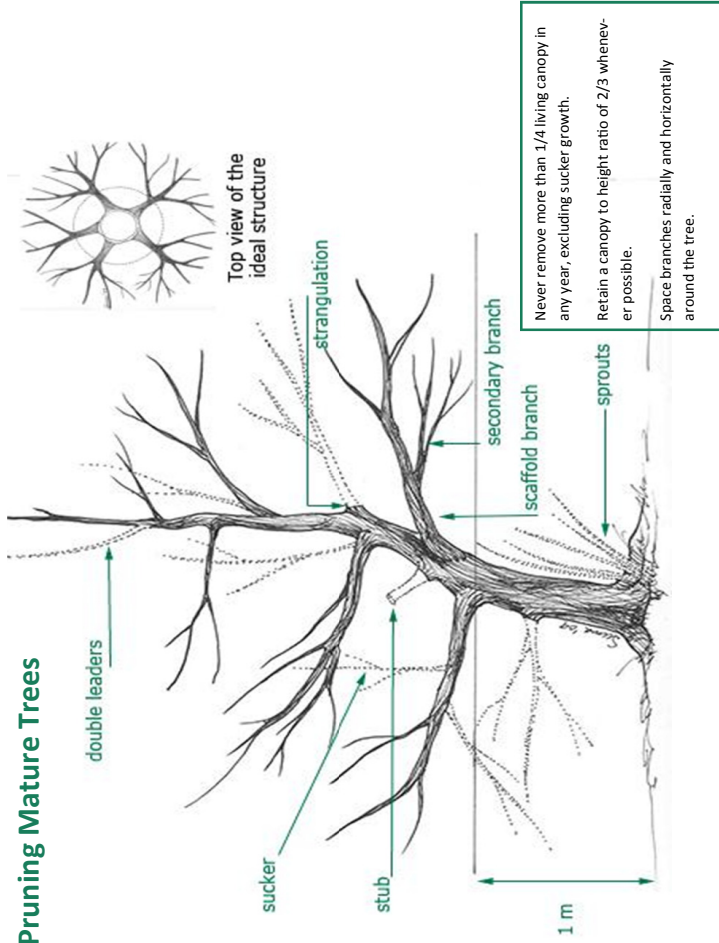
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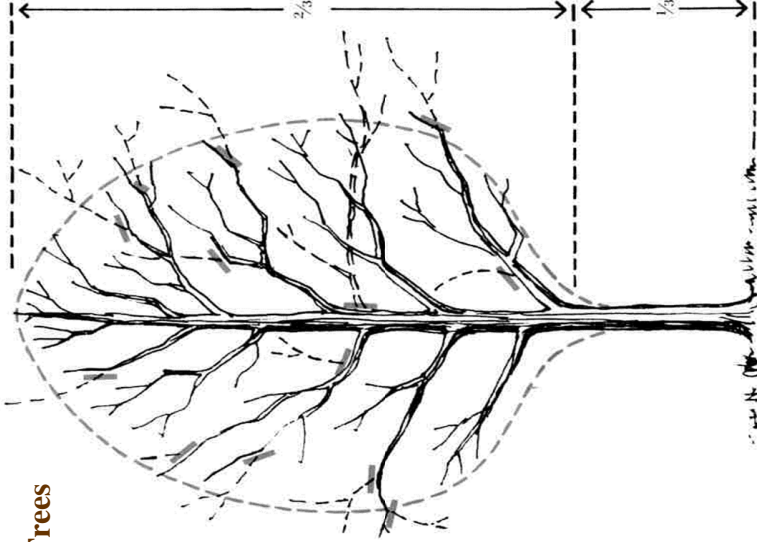


Five Steps to Training Young Trees

1. Remove broken, dead, dying, or damaged branches
2. Select a dominant leader
3. Establish the lowest permanent branch
4. Select remaining scaffold branches
5. Select temporary branches

Never remove more than 1/3 of the living canopy in any year.

Canopy to height ratio should be at least 2/3.

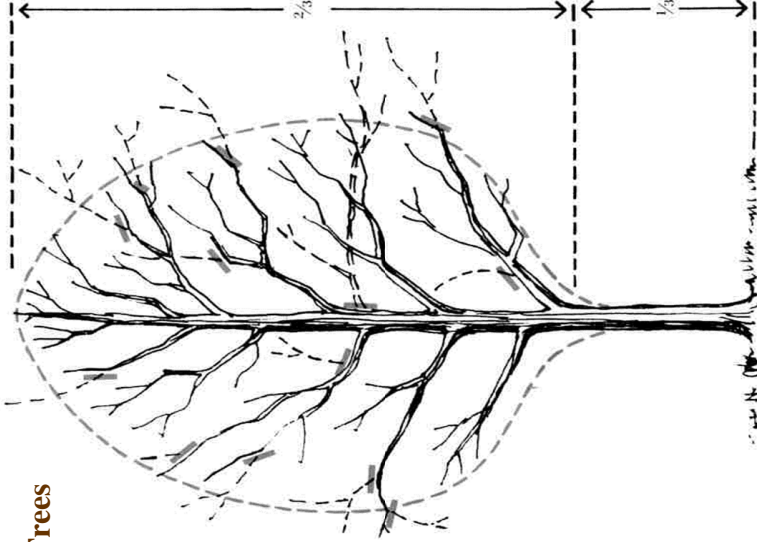


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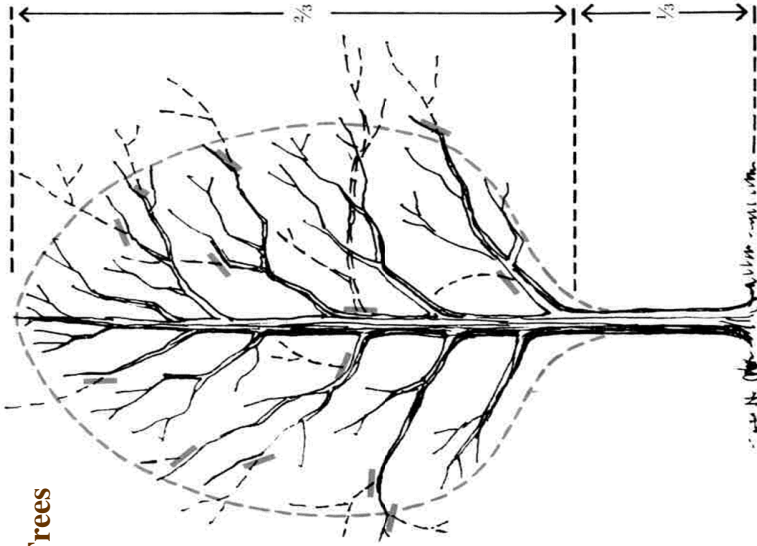


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
